INTRODUCTION

OUR **FREE SQE REVISION APP** IS HERE TO HELP YOU **PREPARE FOR SQE1, PART OF THE SOLICITORS QUALIFYING EXAMINATION (SQE).**

The SQE is the qualifying route for all aspiring solicitors in England and Wales, introduced in 2021. It consists of two sets of assessments, SQE1 and SQE2. SQE1 tests candidates' Functioning Legal Knowledge (FLK), whilst SQE2 tests professional skills.

SQE1 consists of two assessments (FLK 1 and FLK 2) that are taken on two separate days. Each day is further divided into two sessions of 2 hours 33 minutes, with 90 Single Best Answer Questions (SBAQs) to answer in each session - that's a lot of ground to cover in a relatively short time frame, with an average of 1 minute 42 seconds available to answer each question. Students undertaking the assessments will need to be confident they have the right level of knowledge and preparation to succeed.

That's where the ULaw SQE Revision App is here to help.

SQE1 Exam Preparation Course Students	SQE1 Exam Preparation Course students† have access to 162 questions which are taken under examination conditions at a set time. A lecturer can then provide group feedback on results.
SQE Study Manual Owners	If you purchase one of our SQE study manuals (even if you're not an enrolled University of Law student), you'll have access to 40 questions relating to the manual subject area.
Free App Users	A limited version is available to you via app stores if you're not enrolled on a University of Law SQE course or have not purchased a University of Law SQE manual. You just need to provide your email address to access a sample of 45 questions.

** Full SQE courses – these include LLM Legal Practice (SQE1&2), MA Law (SQE1), SQE1 Preparation for Legal Professionals, SQE1 Preparation Course, SQE2 Preparation for Legal Professionals and SQE2 Preparation Course.

† SQE1 Exam Preparation Course students are those who are not taking this short revision course as part of another course, such as SQE1 Preparation Course and SQE1 Preparation for Legal Professionals and have not purchased an SQE manual.

Please note: with MA Law (SQE1), you will only receive full access to the SQE1 Revision App once you start the SQE1 Preparation part of the course.

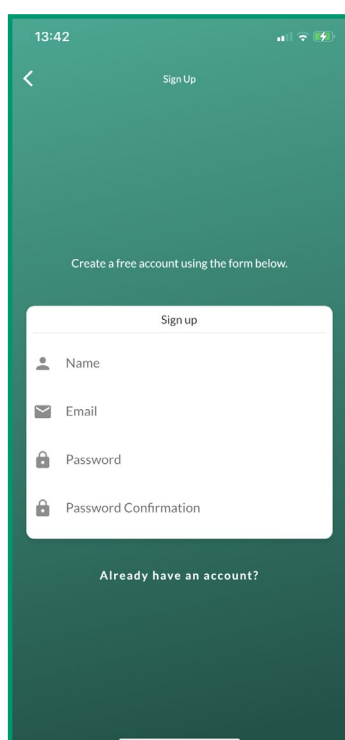
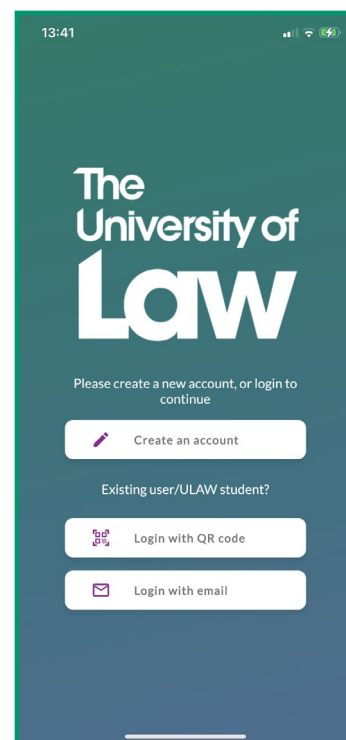
Students enrolled on a University of Law SQE course* will automatically receive full access to the App and can login using a QR code from the Revision Portal practice.law.ac.uk or by using a University of Law email address and a password set on the Portal.

SQE1 EXAM PREP COURSE STUDENTS:

Full login instructions and guidance will be provided upon enrolment on the SQE1 Exam Preparation Course.

SQE STUDY MANUAL OWNERS:

If you have purchased one of our SQE study manuals, you will have access to a set of questions relating to that manual's subject area. A QR code is provided in the inside cover of the manual and when scanned via the ULaw SQE Revision App, will provide access to the questions. There are 40 questions per study manual.



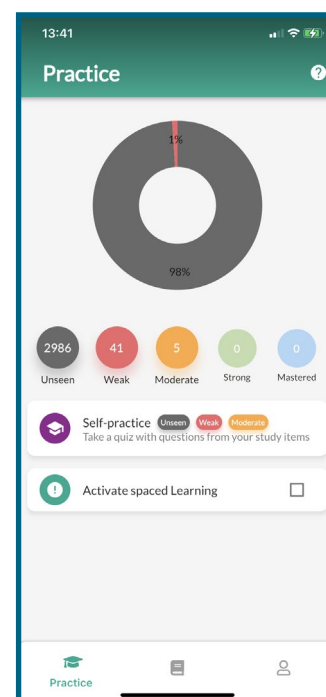
FREE TO USE APP VERSION

To access the App, Click Create an account and input your email, name and chosen password.

PRACTICE DASHBOARD

The first dashboard you'll see is the Practice area, which is where you can begin taking tests. The SQE Revision App hosts several types of Practice Test relevant to your SQE1 study, each with different features and significance.

When you begin using the App your 'Mastery level' will start at 'Unseen', reflecting the fact that you have not yet taken any questions (they are all 'unseen' by you). Select the 'Unseen' icon and the Self Practice Icon to begin taking Self Practice tests using these questions. You will be able to choose from test duration options of Quick, Long, Extra-Long and All Questions and from test modes of Practice or Exam (timed).



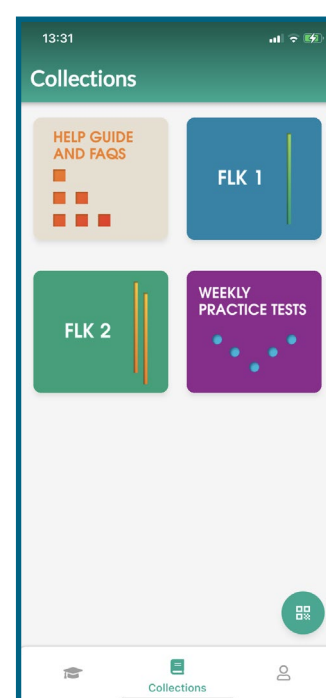
Once you've completed some tests the App will start ranking your progress on the questions you have taken, categorising your performance on a scale from 'Weak' up to 'Mastered'. Progress categories are based on factors that include getting the question correct and time taken to answer. The ideal, through ongoing and repeated practice, is to achieve a 'Mastered' result for all questions in all FLK areas and in the process feel more prepared and confident to attempt the real SQE1 assessment.

The Spaced Learning option takes self-practice even further. In this mode the App itself looks at your strengths and weaknesses so far to generate regular tailored quizzes aimed at improving your performance.

COLLECTIONS DASHBOARD

In the full version of the App, the Collections dashboard contains questions organised by FLK area. If you would prefer to take practice tests by FLK area, use this dashboard to select your area of choice and your desired test mode to start a test.

The Collections dashboard is also your gateway to 'Weekly Practice Tests'. These are curated tests, typically of 15 questions, each one linked to a Unit of study on the University of Law SQE course that you are taking. The Weekly Practice Tests form a crucial, ongoing part of the study model on our SQE courses.
